*Walyunga contains one of the largest known Aboriginal campsites around Perth and was still in use by the Nyoongar people late into the 1800's. Archaeological evidence suggests that the area has been used by regional tribes for more than 6000 years.*

**Where:** Walyunga NP is 20 km north of Midland along the Great Northern Hwy (about an hour's travel from Fremantle, via South St and Roe Hwy).

**When:** Meet by the water's edge at 10.00am for a cuppa.  
The program starts at 10.30.  
Breaking for lunch and finishing around mid/late afternoon.

**How much:** \$35 (\$28 concession)
